

## PAST EVENTS

# Darnum Heritage Display

Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 February

The Darnum Heritage Display, held at our club grounds for the first time, was a remarkable success. The event was run in conjunction with the Trafalgar Truck Restorers Club and represented a significant amount of planning and preparation by members of both clubs.

In the months leading up to the event, and particularly in the final week, considerable work was undertaken to prepare the grounds and facilities. Site layouts were finalised, fences erected, toilets delivered, bins positioned, and the PA system installed. The shed was given a thorough clean, with additional tables and chairs collected and set up, and the kitchen prepared for catering across the weekend. By Thursday, vehicles had begun arriving, with numbers building steadily through Friday and into Saturday.

Saturday saw approximately 150 trucks, 80 cars and 40 tractors on display. In addition, there were steam engines, stationary engines, military vehicles, motorbikes, bulldozers and a range of working exhibits. The display reflected a broad cross-section of trucks, with some travelling as far as interstate to attend. Likely the largest ever display of cars at our grounds were on display, greeting more than 600 members of the public as they arrived throughout the day. Several working demonstrations, including earthmoving and engine displays, added further interest for visitors.

Weather conditions were favourable, contributing to a steady flow of visitors through the gates across both days. The layout of exhibits across the grounds allowed visitors to move easily between the truck displays, car line-ups, tractors and machinery, as well as the club shed.

Saturday evening's meal in the shed was fully booked, with more than 180 meals served. The catering effort, coordinated and delivered by Helen Farley and volunteers, was well received. The evening also included a raffle and auction, both of which were well supported.

The smooth running of the weekend relied on the contribution of many volunteers. Members assisted with gate entry, parking and marshalling, catering, cleaning, monitoring amenities and general coordination throughout the grounds.
